This programme has been put together on the understanding that local COVID-19D restrictions will be eased by 25 October, and that we will be able to use the Harry Higgs room and other venues – probably conditionally – from that date. Course participants will almost certainly be required to prove they have been double vaccinated, masks will probably have to be worn, and is likely that the 4 square metre rule will be invoked.
